



CCOF Coaches Code of Conduct

- **Head / Assistant Coaches** are Mentor's, Teacher's, and Role Models to the Athletes they are around throughout the year.
- **Both are Responsible for:**
 - Player Safety
 - Parent Orientation, NO LATER than first day of Practice
 - Parents' Conduct
 - Procedure for Injury and Insurance Incident Reports
 - HOLD Players accountable for Grades, Attitude, Home Responsibilities
 - Maintain a consistent Practice Schedule
 - Communicate with Parents in Advance of any change
 - ALL Electronic devices are PROHIBITED from Coaches Sidelines during games
 - NOT Videoing any team as a future opponent – NO COACH MAY DO THIS!!!
- **Head / Assistant Coaches are Accountable for:**
 - Attend MANDATORY Coaches Meetings and Clinics
 - Maintaining Rules at Practice & Games
 - Upholding Rules for interacting with Officials
 - Game Ejections
 - No Smoking/Vaping/Chewing Tobacco during Practice & Games
- **Helmets**
 - ONLY **OPTIMIST Issued!!!** NO EXCEPTIONS!!
 - May not change Face Mask

- ABSOLUTELY NO Tape of any kind is allowed on Helmets....NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- NO Colored Hair AT ALL of players...If player has dyed hair, may NOT PLACE HELMET on head until ALL Color is gone from the head...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Visors only With DOCTORS Prescription AND to be installed by CCOF Equipment
- **Jersey's & Equipment:**
 - HEAD COACH responsible for ALL Jersey's issued to Team
 - HEAD COACH WILL get Roster filled out with Jersey Numbers and send to Executive Director
 - **HEAD COACH IS RESPONSIBLE FOR all JERSEY & EQUIPMENT issued to Him/Her at beginning of Season**
 - Canyon County Optimist Football WILL NOT ALLOW Jersey's to be Defaced
 - Players names on back of Jersey are ONLY Allowed for Senior Teams
